RESPONSIBILITIES

- Conduct trafficking case analysis using HT Pro Bono's data resources
- Research and draft fact sheets on human trafficking trends
- Research international human trafficking strategic litigation
- Provide support to supervising attorney as needed

QUALIFICATIONS

- Strong interest and commitment to human rights and public interest law
- Excellent research, writing, and analytical skills
- Excellent communication skills
- Ability to handle several tasks at once while working independently or as a member of a team
- Applicants must be authorized to work in the United States

EDUCATION

Applicants must be law students who are currently enrolled for the duration of the internship term.

INTERNSHIP PERIOD

The internship position will begin in May 2017 and end in August 2017, though dates are flexible.

TIME COMMITMENT

Candidates must be available for 35 hours/week minimum.

SUBMISSION DEADLINE

Open until filled. Applications will be reviewed on a rolling basis.
